Heart Disease and Coronary Calcium Scans

Heart disease, also referred to as Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) is the leading cause of death in the US. Memorial Hospital is now offering scans for this disease called Coronary Calcium Scans. This scan uses CT imaging and is an important way that you and your doctor start to take steps to improve your calcium score.

CAD occurs when the lining of the arteries that supply blood to the heart become hardened, stiffened and swollen with plaque (a buildup of fat and other substances, including calcium), which can, over time, narrow the arteries or even close off blood flow to the heart. The result may be painful angina in the chest or a heart attack.

A heart CT Calcium Score Scan uses relatively low radiation dose and is a non-invasive exam to determine if CAD is present and to what extent, even if there are no symptoms.




